TxDOT closed Highway 21 south of FM 2001 in the **Kyle** area at the bridge due to bridge failure. TxDOT is in the process of setting up a detour. Heavy rains compromised the bridge. No word yet on when it will reopen.

All five transportation modes carried less US freight by value with Canada and Mexico in March 2016 compared to March 2015. The total value of cross-border freight carried on all modes fell 5.8% from 2015 to \$90.5 billion in current dollars, according to the US Department of Transportation.

### ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (and 'Other' News)

The **San Antonio** International Airport and Seabury APG air service development consultants are working together to build a business case for increased air service at the airport and has developed an on-line survey asking questions related to current travel, potential future travel, if a non-stop flight were to be

A new US ambassador to Mexico arrived last week in **Mexico City**. Roberta Jacobson, a career diplomat previously engaged in the effort to normalize relations with Cuba, does not officially assume the post until she has met with President Enrique Pena Nieto. *Story*.
